Venue:

Welcome to Salzburger Land, probably the most beautiful region in the whole of Austria with its rugged mountains, lakes and dark green forests. Here in the heart of the Hohe Tauern National Park you will find Stuhlfelden, site of the 2010 European Bowhunter Championships.

How to reach us:

A selection of useful travel information on how to reach the EBHC 2010

By Air: Stuhlfelden is located within easy reach of two major airports - **Salzburg** (ca. 1 hr. drive) Direct flights from most major European cities served by main airline groups and budget airlines. **Munich International Airport** (ca. 2 hrs.) is served by most national and international airlines. Subject to demand a value for money transfer service can be put in place.

By Rail: As a leading tourist area, international train services are available to the main local rail terminal – Zell am See (ca. 14 mile from Stuhlfelden) with connecting Bus or narrow-gage railway services to the Championship venue.

By Car: Excellent main road connections exist to Stuhlfelden. North/South and East/West

From Germany: E45 motorway Munich - Rosenheim - Kufstein then by way of national route via St.Johann – Kitzbühel and over the Pass Thurn to Mittersill. From Mittersill you take the route 168 direction Zell am See to nearby Stuhlfelden (+/- 3 miles)

From Italy: A22/E45 motorway Bolzano-Brenner Pass-Innsbruck. From Innsbruck continue via the E45 motorway to Kufstein – then follow route as above.

Slovenija: Ljubljana E61 to Villach then via the A11/10 as far as Knoten-Bischofshofen – Follow route 311 to Zell am See. Continue on route 168 direction Mittersill. After +/- 16 km. you will reach Stuhlfelden.

Switzerland: E60 motorway from Zürich to Feldkirch thence via the E60 (A12) by way of Innsbruck to Kufstein. Then follow route as indicated above from Germany.



EBHC 2010:

For the 2010 Championship, local conditions permit **large** participation with range facilities being tailored to the number of participants.

The EBHC 2010 will be held strictly in accordance with the International Field Archery Association regulations. Details of the regulations can be found in EBHC Homepage under www.ebhc2010.at with additional links to the IFAA and the ÖBSV.

The veteran styles caters archers who are 55 years old or more on the first day of a tournament. Veterans may decide to compete in either the Adult styles or in the Veteran styles, however, not in both. Proof of the age will be required. There are no performance styles for veterans.

Junior Styles (13 – 16 year)

The Junior styles caters for archers under the age of 17 years at the first day of a tournament. Acceptable proof of age must be submitted.

The Cub styles caters for archers under the age of 13 years at the first day of a tournament. Acceptable proof of age must be submitted.

**The EBHC 2010 will take place over 5 days, made up of 4 competition days and 1 rest day.
The actual rest day varies according to which division has been entered.**

To be shot:

- 2 IFAA 3-D Rounds – unmarked Animal Rounds (three arrows)
- 1 IFAA 3-D Standard Round (two arrows)
- 1 IFAA 3-D Hunter Round (one arrow)

Please note:

Consumption of alcohol and smoking (except in clearly designated smoking zones) is strictly forbidden on the shooting and training ranges.
Cellphones are also forbidden on the courses.
Participants contravening these rules will be disqualified.
The IFAA Code of Conduct is valid for this EBHC.
